## Spotlight on History!

Manatee Memorial Hospital was first proposed in 1939 by the <u>Bradenton Woman's Club</u> and other prominent members of the community. "A memorial to Manatee County veterans of all wars. Contributed by the public of Manatee County. "The pictured hospital, Manatee Veterans Memorial Hospital opened in February of 1953 as a public hospital with 100 beds. The hospital began as a concept by the Bradenton Woman's Club and other community leaders in 1939. Delayed by World War II, fundraising did not begin until 1947. In 1963, the state legislature renamed to Manatee Memorial Hospital, dropping the 'Veterans' to avoid confusion, since it was not a Veterans Administration hospital. Today Manatee Memorial Hospital is a leading public hospital of 319 beds with many specialties such as orthopedics and heart care.
