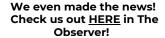

Health & Wellness Tip

Healthy Balsamic Chicken and Vegetables Ingredients

• ¼ cup bottled Italian salad dressing / 2 Tbsp. balsamic vinegar / 1 Tbsp. honey% - ¼ tsp. crushed red pepper / 2 Tbsp. olive oil / 1 lb. chicken breast tenderloins / 1 (10-oz.) package fresh asparagus, trimmed and cut into 2-inch pieces, or one 10-ounce package frozen cut asparagus, thawed and well drained / 1 cup purchased shredded carrot / 1 small tomato, seeded and chopped

Directions

1. In a small bowl, stir together salad dressing, balsamic vinegar, honey, and crushed red pepper. Set aside. 2. In a large skillet, heat oil over medium-high heat. Add chicken; cook for 5 to 6 minutes or until chicken is tender and no longer pink, turning once. Add half of the dressing mixture to skillet; turn chicken to coat.

Transfer chicken to a serving platter; cover and keep warm.

3. Add asparagus and carrot to skillet. Cook and stir for 3 to 4 minutes or until asparagus is crisp-tender; transfer

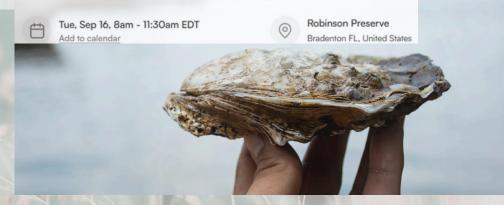
to serving platter.

4. Stir remaining dressing mixture; add to skillet. Cook and stir for 1 minute, scraping up browned bits from bottom of skillet. Drizzle the dressing mixture over chicken and vegetables. Sprinkle with tomato. Makes 4 servings.
